IAMU Call for research proposals

IAMU has been supporting research for many years and has funded many projects in the past. IAMU has launched a new research programme and intends to fund a number of projects under three themes:

- Theme 1 Marine environment protection
- Theme 2 STCW 2010 challenge for MET institutions, and
- Theme 3 Shipping challenges.

The may be a fourth theme depending on the resources available and if the activities proposed is in line with the IAMU's objectives and goals.

The project is expected to:

- Counter critical issues in maritime safety and environmental protection.
- Transfer maritime skills and knowledge to the next generations.
- Contribute to the well being of the international maritime community.

Also, likewise in the case of last year, this year "20% overheads" is admitted in calculating budget amount for the projects, to make up for a part of the relevant institution's personnel cost.

Those who are interested in submitting a research proposal for one of the themes should visit the IAMU website to download the application form, and

- (1) Prepare the research proposal in line with aims and objectives of the theme.
- (2) Submit the form to the IAMU Secretary's Office as given below by July 31, 2011 (Japan Time).
