TUDEV and C4FF plans to visit IMarEST (The Institute of Marine Engineering, Science & Technology) (www.imarest.org) and Lloyd's Register (<http://www.lr.org>) in 24 May 2012. This visit will be to disseminate and exploit IMPACT platform's novel and innovative products (www.maritimetraining.pro). The meeting will involve seeking accreditation and support from IMarEST and developing a strategy for Human Factors with Lloyd's.
