UniMET (Unification of Marine Training and Education) – www.unimet.pro

UniMET project is progressing well. The further tasks were allocated to project partners after the third partner meeting in London.

Turkish partner (TUDEV) is carrying out monitoring visits to UniMET MET partners under WP 2 – Identification of national requirements, methods and preparation of materials for implementation of UniMET in the partner institutions. First two monitoring visits were carried out in January to Lithuanian partner, Lithuanian Maritime Academy (LMA) and Finland partner, Satakunta university of Applied Sciences (SUAS).
